ENTANGENI ADOLESCENT GIRLS' MOVEMENT

We are looking to contract on a voluntary basis, five (5) post graduate or unemployed Social Science and or law female graduates based in Makhanda; to collect data from fifty (50) adolescent girls from Makhanda schools. Priority will be given to young women (ages 18-35) interested and committed to the principles of Sexual and Reproductive Health Rights (SRHR) of adolescent girls.

Entangeni Adolescent Girls Movement's (EAGM) purpose is to <u>'create opportunities for</u> <u>adolescent girls to promote self-reliance and bodily autonomy - thereby helping to break the poverty cycle for themselves and their families.'</u>

Selected individuals will be expected to undertake the following:

- Attend a half a day online orientation workshop (+-4 hours), which will focus on how to utilise the data collection toolkit which will be used to collect data.
- Facilitate +-4 hour Focus Group Discussions (FGD) of +- 10 adolescent girls each, which will take place over 4 consecutive Saturday mornings at TEM Mrwetyana Secondary School;
- Document and record discussions that take place during the FGD;
- Scribe data collected;

ENGF will provide the following:

- Transport to and fro Mrwetyana Secondary School and refreshments for all the Saturday sessions;
- Funding for the data collectors' honorarium;
- Recording equipment
